2013: delicate with shy nose, some texture and green fruits. Pear notes come through with a creamy finish.	2013	86	2013-2019
2014: dry and sinewy, with oak and Malo over yellow fruit. Rather simple and brief.	2014	82	2014-2022

2010: jokey name for a serious wine, layered, intense and beautifully balanced; all smokey chocolate and plum.	2010	90	2010-2022

2010: Cab Franc dominated nose, then round, plump fruit and classy oak, sweetly fruited and long.
