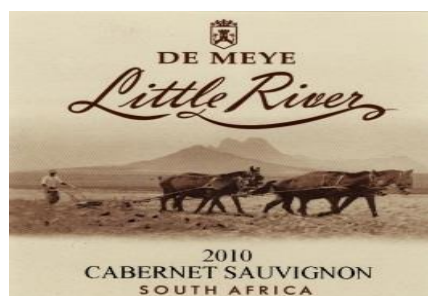

Sauvignon Blanc R

2020: bold tropical fruit nose, guava and passion fruit, slightly muted clean palate, mineral, almost steely finish.	2020	86	2020-2027

BF Chenin Blanc RR

2011: pale straw, light style, softened acidity and mellow, easy to enjoy.	2011	87	2011-2019
2014: green apple all the way, chunky, chewy and cleanly flavoured.	2014	84	2014-2020
2017: pale, citrus based with savoury herb notes, rather fleeting.	2017	82	2017-2024
2018: deep straw, rich full nose, skin contact texture, wild honey, jasmine and cream, quite exotic and lovely. Hugely improved.	2018	91	2019-2029
2019: nicely coloured and with a lean crisp apple nose, more weight on the palate, peach and summer fruits, clean if brief.	2019	88	2019-2029

Unwooded Chardonnay R

2011: lowish alcohol (12.5%) and a clean, zesty peach and lime fruit forward style.	2011	85	2011-2017
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2014: weighty and lush with underlying briskness and straightforward yellow fruits.	2014	84	2014-2020
2015: even lower alcohol at 12% and mixed green fruits with softened tropical edge. Pleasant if not remarkable.	2015	82	2015-2024
2017: pale and bright if watery, with short citrus fruit impact.	2017	80	2017-2026
2018: pale depth, fruity clean nose, very dry with mellow stone fruit balance, somewhat laid-back.	2018	86	2018-2026
2020: barely coloured and with a modest stone fruit nose then soft and generous mouthfeel, nicely balanced.	2020	86	2020-2027

Rosé

R

2011: pale pink delicate floral nose belies the punchy dry Shiraz fruit exploding on the palate.	2011	86	2011-2017
2014: meringue and Turkish delight nose, viscous, full palate with noticeable alcohol warmth.	2014	84	2014-2019
2017: very light hues, strawberry and watermelon notes, crisp and dry.	2017	84	2017-2023
2018: pink hint, floral impact, light strawberry and rosewater, lip-smacking and very ripe fruited, nicely dry.	2018	84	2018-2025
2019: just a tinge of colour, lots of red berry and strawberry ripe fruit, juicy and vibrant if light.	2019	86	2019-2025
2020: textured fresh cherry fruit nose, ripe succulent berry fruit palate, easy, dry and pleasant.	2020	85	2020-2026

Merlot

RR

2009: mid ruby, perfumed nose all mint and cherry. Sweet fruit palate, raspberry and chary toast oak.	2009	88	2010-2018
2015: dense and earthy, with wood spice	2015	87	2015-2025

and bold red berry full bodied feel.

Cabernet Franc

RR

2019: glossy inky depth, rich nose with oak notes then cherry and forest berry fruit, layered, dry and very classy.

Myburgh & Milner Privateer Red

RR

2016: quite pale then bold juicy nose of dark mixed fruits and cherry, soft and easy with a spice hint, undemanding.

2016 88 2017-2026

Little River Cabernet Sauvignon

R

2010: juicy blackcurrant fruit, dry tannins in a slightly rustic, gutsy style with bold and forthright fruit and quite distinctive.

2010 87 2010-2018

2012: nicely restrained and with hedgerow berries and herby notes. Simple and honest.

2012 85 2012-2020

2013: strangely baked, perhaps too hot ferment resulting in a hardly recognisable Cabernet.

2013 76 2013-2022

2015: touch baked black spicy fruit, inoffensive berried offering.

2015 77 2015-2022

Little River Shiraz

R

2011: very deep hue, tar and sweet peppery fruit on the nose, ripe tannins, already approachable.

2010 86 2010-2017

2013: easy-going, dark fruited with supple

2013 84 2013-2021

mouthfeel and hints of blackberry spice.			
2015: touch sappy from wood tannins, mixed dark fruit with soft approach.	2015	82	2015-2024

Shiraz R

2009: opaque, expressive black fruit nose then bold, rich fruit and herbs with grippy tannins.	2009	89	2010-2018
2012: needs time to conquer the dry, grippy tannins and chewy oak. Dark, dense spicy fruit underneath.	2012	85	2012-2022
2015: light depth but deep red and black fruit compote with oak in a soft manner.	2015	85	2016-2026
2020: a wine to chill first, easy-fruited, quite light, very smooth, deft and full of juicy soft mulberries.	2020	87	2020-2027

Cabernet Sauvignon RR

2009: perfect cedar and cassis nose, liqueur and luscious fruit, plush mulberry style reminds of Chile, ripe and pristine.	2009	92	2011-2020
2015: mid depth, cherry and blackcurrant, lush and full with nicely balanced wood.	2015	86	2016-2027
2017: inky depth, cassis and lavender burst, dark lozenge fruits, big and tight with spice but finishing nicely smooth.	2017	90	2018-2028

Trutina RRR

2010: opaque, rich blue fruit nose, deep ,layered and silky. Slight burnt coffee bean finish, classy and long. Will improve.	2010	92	2011-2020
2013: classic game and leather development	2013	89	2015-2024
