2006: some fading and leaner fruit but still with power and delicious pencil and black fruit flavours.	2006	87	2006-2018
2008: nice tertiary leather notes still good dark fruit impact, long and elegant. Very nice.	2008	88	2008-2018
2011: deep and rustic, with spicy grip but developing quickly.	2011	85	2011-2022
2016: suffered from the vintage or hot fermentation – rather porty and marmite-like, still enjoyable though.	2016	82	2016-2024

2019: mid purple depth, juicy overt nose, very fruity, bright blue berry notes easy-going and fun.	2019	85	2019-2026

2018: sweet fruit nose, bold clean currants and hedgerow berry notes, smooth and friendly.	2018 87 2018-2028
