2010: serious nose, complex, layours of white fruit flavours and a rich, full palate of peaches, pears and sweet oak hints. Needs to settle. Quite delicious.	2010	90	2010-2020

2015: oaky nose and texture, but balanced by deep mulberry fruit, dry finish.	2015 87 2016-2026
2016: subdued nose then rustic and earthy cherry dark fruit in an approachable, easy-going style.	2016 87 2017-2027
2017: restrained nose, just mid weight, lots of hedgerow dark fruits and summer berries, open and honest.	2017 88 2018-2028

2013: sweet, juicy nose, drier and serious on the palate, easy drinking but quite classy.	2013 89 2014-2024
2014: inky deep, oak and spice, soft fruits, cassis and dusty tannins, very accessible.	2014 85 2014-2025
2016: deep purple hue, violet plum nose, dusty tannins, dry, sinewy currant notes, quite big for the vintage, lovely.	2016 91 2018-2028

2009: mid hue, rich nose of violets and spice, explodes on the palate, pristine sweet fruit, delicate elegant touch.	2009	91	2011-2021

2013: deep purple, soft and voluptuous, quite intense with cassis and spice rustic notes.	2013	89	2014-2024

2007: mid coloured, subdued nose, tannic backbone which needs another 5 years then the blue fruit will assert into a delightful, complex wine of real class.	2007	91	2010-2020

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2012: still inky despite 3years in bottle, overt dusky forest nose, textured, grippy, delicious.	2012	93	2014-2028
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2013: opaque and shiny, with a funky, almost rustic nose, then leafy and dark fruited, opening to richness and good fruit quality. Good food wine.	2013	92	2015-2028
