Sauvignon Blanc

RR

2018: medium bodied with a steely lime and green fruit note, lots of muted lemon and herbs, surefooted and satisfying.

Reisling

RR

2015: with a WO from the Rheingau in Germany, this tangy, apple and orange wine is crisp and viscous enough, but lacks complexity and length.

2015 83 2017-2023

Chenin Blanc

RR

2018: mid bodied yet with subtle nuanced floral aromas and gentle flavours of pear and stone fruit, competent and likeable, but it feels muted.

2018 87 2019-2028

Stolen Chicken Rosé

RR

2018: quite deeply hued and weighty, with 14% alcohol

2018 83 2018-2025

and a confected, liquid raspberry and rose hip sweet-shop nature, thankfully dry.

Red Blend RR

2015: smoky oak and winter hedgerow fruit with red berries, generous and very soft, with good integration, quite easy-going.

2015 87 2016-2025

Merlot RR

2017: medium bodied but feels plentiful, with woody texture and plush deep fruits, very soft tannins and succulent mouthfeel.

2017 89 2018-2028

Cabernet Sauvignon RRR

2017: muscular and full of black berry and blackcurrant notes with tangy savoury oak and almost an 'edge' to it. Big and not nuanced.

2017 88 2019-2028

Shiraz RRR

2015: chargrilled meat nose, full black fruited with pepper and spice, slightly cooked and not very defined, but effective.
