

Shiraz, big, rather 'hot' with hedgerow			
cherry bite			
2016: dusty and rustic, with dark spicy fruit punch,	2016	90	2017-2027
savoury and textured and full.			
2018: dry and yet offering bright, almost juicy,	2018	90	2019-2028
dark winter fruits and earth note, full and satisfying.
