

2014: reliably easy drinking, fruity and dark,	2014	79	2014-2022
but if it was a colour it would be beige.			
2015: similarly rather anonymous, with	2015	78	2015-2025
dark, juicy fruit and mass appeal, finishing			
swiftly.			
2016: deep cherry nose, hint of wood, tangy	2016	84	2016-2026
and juicy with a smooth mouthfeel.			
2017: red-plum tinge, a lighter, elegant style with	2017	86	2017-2027
a spice hint and fleeting, accessible fruit.

needing time to show.
