Vintage Score best drinking

MCC Brut

RR

Pale hue, plumpish bubbles with a light texture. Straightforward and shortish with feint biscuit edge.

NV 80 1-5 years

Sauvignon Blanc

RR

2011: very pale, nettles and grass on the nose, less fulfilling on the palate, savoury with zippy citrus fruit in a light style.

2011 76 2011-2016

2012: classic gooseberry nose and palate, quite intense and with pleasant nettle finish. Refreshing.

2012 85 2012-2018

2014: not overly fruity, quite shy but nicely mineral and crisp.

2014 85 2014-2020

2017: bright nose and a viscous texture, with steely crisp citrus notes.

2017 84 2017-2023

2018: pale depth with gooseberry and slight tropical notes, very dry and tight and with a mineral finish.

2018 86 2018-2026

2019: aromatic and forward, with pineapple and banana tropical warmth, slight metallic note on a dry and lighter style.

2018: Cabernet based with copper orange tinge, fruity nose some grapefruit and savoury texture, quite full and rich.	2018	86	2019-2026
2019: rusty copper hue, with big fruity nose and a dry and slightly muted berry palate, a touch brief.	2019	86	2019-2026

2006: mid hue, some ageing showing but still strawberry and roses on the nose with forest fruits and pencil shavings dominating. Firm acidity and touch leaner than '04, but finish is pleasant. Drink soon.	2006	87	2007-2018
2007: showing development with soft cassis notes and clever oak. Very dry with firm tannins on a classy wine showing nicely.	2007	89	2009-2019
2012: bold and deep, with oak hints and a silky finish with improvement to come.	2012	86	2012-2021
2013: step-up in quality, opaque ruby, layered blue fruits with spicy oak and good length.	2013	92	2015-2024
2014: clean, easy-going with lots of soft blue fruit and mulberry impact.	2014	88	2015-2025
2015: cedar and currant nose, smooth and silky with generous, seamless fruit layers, long and lush and delicious.	2015	93	2018-2030
2017: pre-release is mid ruby to black, full and spicy with lush dark fruits, length and real presence, will improve yet.	2017	91	2021-2031

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2011: tightly knit with big tannins and generous fruit needing time to unwind; should be nice.

2011 90 2011-2022

2015: shy nose, mid weight and smooth, accessible tannins. Ripe and attractive.

2017: inky depth, serious nose of oak and winter dark fruits, punchy blue fruit comes through, long and compelling.
